

North End context

- **Population** - 4,871 residents as of the 2021 Census
- **Park and greenspace** - Bayfront Park, Bayview Park, Bennetto Elementary School, Eastwood Park, Jackie Washington Park, Pier 4 Park, Pier 8 Park, Sunset Garden
- **Neighbourhood ranking** - Most greenspace in Ward 2 by neighbourhood, but still ranks low citywide

Eastwood Park

Medium Term

- 2024 - New splash pad - approved in the previous term of Council
- 2025 - New fencing, grading, sand and pathway improvements
- 2026 - Drinking fountains and pathway improvements; washrooms?
- 2027 - Landscape Architecture staff received a request to review improvements to the Park including the **relocation of park and sport field amenities**, reviving the pool, washrooms, and right sizing ball diamonds, all of which requires a **Master Plan** process

Eastwood Arena

- Rink - brining equipment
- Old pool - currently buried
- Heating and cooling - not installed
- Roof - in stable condition
- Change rooms - in good condition




Eastwood Arena

- Schedule for ice, in the past, was October to March only - this limited all non ice activities to April to September only
- There has not been ice in the arena for nearly 4 years
- The costs to operate an ice rink are considerable - brining equipment and other issues
- Booking hours **up by 65%** since removing ice programming

Eastwood Arena - Survey

What should happen with Eastwood Arena?



Eastwood Arena

Short Term

- 2025 - Temporary closure; will continue to be used in 2026 with monitoring and minor improvements - approximately \$100-200k

Medium Term

- 2026 and 2027 - Recreation Master Plan Implementation Strategy approved **immediate** study of the feasibility of reusing this site and developing a plan

Eastwood Arena

Medium Term

- 2026 - Funding allocated for **Feasibility Study**
- Will require between \$1m-3m to keep it functioning, as is, beyond 2026 - no funding allocated for this at the moment
- Dome?

Long Term

- Potential for a “vertical” Community Centre with housing above



Strachan Linear Park



Strachan Linear Park

- Approximately 2km² of programmable space
- Parking lot in the centre of the space is about 300-400m² (approximate size of a full sized basketball court)




Strachan Linear Park

- The area became “surplus land” and the community asked if I could work on programming it
- After discussions with CN Railway, I approached City staff and I put forward a motion at Council in **2024** to begin the work of transforming this space
- Any work will take years to complete, but some things can happen more quickly than others

Strachan Linear Park

Short Term

- 2025 - Benches, new garbage cans, replacing steel drums in many places
 - moved around at the request of the community
- 2025 and 2026 - Soil testing
- 2026 - Fence design, removal, and reinstallation

Medium Term

- 2026 and 2027 - Concept design and community consultation
